On March 19, 2020, under the direction of the President's Coronavirus Guidelines for America the U.S. Department of Homeland Security issued its **Memorandum on Identification of Essential Critical Infrastructure Workers During COVID-19 Response**. Also, per Governor Roy Cooper's directive, Engineered Controls International, LLC, (otherwise known as 'RegO') is considered an essential manufacturer of critical infrastructure.
